Features The Homebrew Channel is essentially an interface which allows developers to build and publish homebrews to it. The general availability of the Homebrew Channel is announced in early November 2012. History In April and May 2012, two separate HBC development kits for Wii and Wii U were announced. The first kit is a Wii-based development kit, the second kit is a Wii U-based development kit. At the 2013 Consumer Electronics Show in January, Nintendo CEO Satoru Iwata announced that the Wii U development kit is set for release by April 2013. Later that month, Nintendo released a Wii U HBC developer toolkit. In March, Nintendo released development software for the Wii and Wii U. In April and May, Nintendo released the Wii HBC and Wii U HBC development kits. The Wii HBC includes development software for the Wii console, while the Wii U HBC includes software for the Wii U console. In July 2013, Nintendo released development software for the Nintendo 3DS. In May 2013, Nintendo announced at E3 that an unofficial Homebrew channel for the Wii U would be available to the public. Later that month, the Homebrew application will be available as a download for the Wii U, Wii, and Nintendo 3DS consoles. In October 2013, Nintendo announced that the Nintendo 3DS development kit would include the Homebrew Channel, and released the Homebrew Channel for the Wii U, Nintendo 3DS, and Wii U consoles
