The invisible thread In the late 19th century, French cultural anthropologist Françoise Lévy-Bruhl worked with Haitian Vodou spirits. Her research focused on the bonds between members of a spiritual community, especially in Haiti. She postulated the concept of the invisible thread of the world, in which the spirits of a village could be identified by a pattern or pattern of houses (the town) in which they dwelt. A person could be given access to the spirits of the land or a village by being sewn together with the invisible thread. Lévy-Bruhl also worked with the Serer tribe of Senegal, where the term was the "big mana". The ceremony had the purpose of preparing warriors for combat.
